Maintenance Matters!!

It has been an especially warm summer. Our maintenance team has done a fantastic job of keeping our community looking good despite the heat. The pool and clubhouse area were popular spots for residents to escape the heat, and the area was well maintained considering the heavy use by residents. Many residents were especially appreciative of the new water fountain and the remodeled bathrooms at the pool area.

In the coming weeks, the water features on the north and east side of the community will receive an upgrade due to a new pump and motor being installed in the Lakeview pump house. The Board will be replacing other pumps and motors in the future as part of the long-range plan to systematically replace the original pumps and motors in the community. The original pumps and motors have reached their limits of repair possibilities due to age. Reserve funds will be used for the replacement of pumps and motors.

The winter grass overseed will commence in the first week of October. Again, this year only the clubhouse common areas and main entrance will be overseeded to reduce water usage but still retain a pleasant community landscape. Once the overseed project is completed the Soho Park project to add a community gate for residents to access the Paseo Canal will begin. Should residents have any maintenance concerns or suggestions please contact our Property Manager.
